Slalom

The <u>Slalom World Championship</u> (Men) was held in Westerland, Sylt, Germany, from 22nd to 26th July. The championship was the premier event in this year's Volvo Surf Cup, one of the most prestigious windsurfing events on the international calendar. World Champion – Vincent Langer (Germany)

The <u>Slalom Youth & Masters World Championships</u> were held in Reggio Calabria, Italy, from 29thJune to 4th July. Youth World Champion – Nicolas Goyard (France) Masters world Champion – Andrea Rosati (Italy

The <u>Slalom JYM European Championships</u> were held at Almanarre Beach in Hyere, France, from 28th April to 3rd May. Masters Champion – Alejandro Rodriguez (Spain) Junior Champion – Jimmy Thieme (France) Youth Champion – Nicolas Goyard (France)

The <u>Slalom European Championships</u> (Men) took place within a tour of 4 events organized by Choppywater, Germany. European Champion – Vincent Langer (Germany)

A South American Slalom Championships will take place in Brasil in December.

Freestyle

The <u>European Championship</u> was sanctioned through the EFPT (European Freestyle Pro Tour) – this year's tour has yet to be completed.
