Submission 4 – Board Registration System

Submission withdrawn with a WP formed to work with World Sailing on simplifying the process of board registration. Especially: reduce number of required board manufactured, reduce the technical requirements for brands to register their boards.

Submission 5 – Long distance racing

Approved unanimously with the Executive Committee to work on ways of implementing long distance in IFCA activities.
